Leonora Carrington often took the hyena as her doppelgänger to probe dark and unbridled female energy in her paintings and short stories. We take the hyena as our moniker for her feral and ravenous nature, her ability to provoke mix-ups in gender identity, and her proclivity for habitation in matriarchal clans.
